

The Azad Laboratory at the University of Maryland School of Medicine (Baltimore, MD) is seeking a Postdoctoral Fellow to study molecular mechanisms operating at the host/vector/pathogen interface.

Two NIH Funded Projects in the Azad Lab cover a wide range of focal areas, including vector biology, host-pathogen interaction, immunology (e.g., innate immunity), microbiology, cell biology, and biochemistry.

For this position, a Ph.D. is required, and all candidates should have basic experience in standard laboratory techniques for molecular biology/genetics and/or immunology.

Prior work experience within the field of vector biology and obligate intracellular bacteria is a plus but not required.

Ideally, the candidate should have the ability to work independently and as part of a team.

Compensation will be determined based on experience and current NIH guidelines.
