



The Department of Biology at Shippensburg University invites applications for a tenure track position in Mammalian Physiology starting August 2022. Primary responsibilities include teaching of upper-level Human Physiology and an upper-division course based on the applicant's area of expertise. Teaching responsibilities may also include instruction in a two-course introductory-level sequence of Human Anatomy and Physiology, instruction of a graduate course that complements current offerings in the department, and/or introductory courses for majors or non-majors. In addition to fulfillment of teaching responsibilities, the candidate will be expected to conduct scholarly activity, with an emphasis on student research, and service to the University. Faculty members are expected to perform other duties as assigned in compliance with the collective bargaining agreement.

Candidates must have a Ph.D. in Biology or a related field from an accredited institution completed by May 31, 2022.

For an application to be considered complete, candidates must submit a letter of application, curriculum vitae, statement of teaching philosophy, statement of research interests, names and contact information for three references, and unofficial undergraduate and graduate transcripts (official transcripts required if granted an on-campus interview). Incomplete applications will not be considered.

As part of a successful on-campus interview process, candidates will be expected to provide a demonstration of teaching effectiveness, a research seminar, and evidence of understanding diverse populations.
